Dear Potential Vendor,

Christ Lutheran Church is planning to host the 2023 Pewaukee / Lake Country Farmers Market. By signing the application, you are agreeing to follow the Guidelines set forth by the 2023 Pewaukee / Lake Country Farmers Market. Please read the application carefully.

Enclosed with this letter are the 2023 Vendor Application and the Market Guidelines. The location of the Pewaukee / Lake Country Farmers Market will be Christ Lutheran Church's parking lot. All stalls will accommodate a **10'x10' tent**. The spaces are numbered on the pavement. Do not go past the markings at the front of your space. Every effort will be made to create an appropriate marketing environment.

Hours for the Pewaukee / Lake Country Farmers Market are **Wednesdays from 3:00 pm to 7:00 pm, June 7 through September 27, 2023.**

- **Daily Vendors pay \$40 per Wednesday.** Daily Vendors pay on the day of their attendance.
- **Full Season** (June 1 – Sept. 27) vendors pay \$300.
- **Peak Season** (June 28 – Sept. 27) vendors pay \$250.
- There will be an **Early Bird Discount of \$50** from above prices **if full payment, application, and certificate of insurance liability** (for \$100,000/\$300,000 aggregate) **is received before March 29, 2023.**
- **Vendors sending in their application after March 29, 2023 will pay full price.**
- Craft vendors are allowed to compose approximately 15% of the Farmers Market vendors. **Craft vendors must supply photos of themselves creating/assembling their items.**
- No brokers, agents, tiered sales, or commissioned sellers will be approved as vendors.
- **Make checks out to Christ Pewaukee,** on memo line please write **Farmers Market.**

The Pewaukee/Lake Country Farmers Market will open on Wednesday, June 7, 2023. It is important to have the stalls full on that day. Even if your product is not available for purchase that day, we strongly encourage you to attend and consider providing information on the products that you will have available.

If you are a new food vendor, you must include the necessary permits from the Health Department, or your application will not be accepted. If you have any questions, contact the Waukesha County Division of Environmental Health at 262-896-8326.

Vendors who intend to use a generator must indicate that on the application form. Generator use at the Market will be limited. You must have prior written or emailed permission from the Pewaukee / Lake Country Farmers Market to run your generator. Generators will be inspected by Market Management for noise level, fumes, disturbance to neighboring vendors, and safety. If your generator does not meet approval, you will need to plan for an alternative power source the following week. If your generator is deemed an immediate safety problem, you will be asked to stop the generator immediately.

Final vendor approval and vendor locations in the market will be at the discretion of Market Management. **Once you are assigned your space it will not be changed.** Unresolved disputes over issues can result in cancellation of a vendor's contract.

With your application, **you MUST provide copies of all licensing required by the State of Wisconsin and Waukesha County as well as a Certificate of Liability Insurance** listing Christ Lutheran Church and the Pewaukee / Lake Country Farmer's Market as Additional Insureds.

When completing your application, include the exact address where the produce is grown (not intersections or city only). Incomplete applications will not be accepted. Upon signing the form, you agree to an on-site inspection of your growing area and cooperation with the Market Management team.

Please return this form with all sections filled in, along with your Certificate of Liability Insurance listing Christ Lutheran Church and the Pewaukee / Lake Country Farmers Market as Additional Insureds, \$100,000/\$300,000 aggregate, and **full payment by March 29, 2023 to get your \$50 early bird discount.** Applications received by March 29, 2023 without a Certificate of Liability insurance will NOT receive the \$50 discount. Checks are to be made payable to: Christ Lutheran Church. Approved vendors will receive their assigned stalls and a vendor map by May 10, 2023 via email unless requested to be mailed through USPS. Make checks out to Christ Pewaukee, on note line write Farmers Market.

2023 Pewaukee / Lake Country Farmers Market Guidelines

- Every vendor participating in the 2023 Pewaukee / Lake Country Farmers Market **MUST** have a **Certificate of Liability Insurance**, \$100,000/\$300,000 aggregate, **listing Christ Lutheran Church and the Pewaukee / Lake Country Farmers Market on the certificate as Additional Insureds**. Your insurance provider can provide you with this certificate. Vendors will not be allowed to participate in the market without the Certificate of Liability Insurance which must be provided to Christ Lutheran Church before the market begins on June 7, 2023.
- The Pewaukee / Lake Country Farmers Market hours are 3:00 pm – 7:00 pm on Wednesdays from June 7 through September 27, 2023.
- The Farmers Market site will be located at Christ Lutheran Church's parking lot in Pewaukee, (W240N3103 Pewaukee Road, Pewaukee, WI 53072). Approved vendors will receive their stall assignments and vendor maps by **May 10, 2023**. Notices will be mailed through USPS by request only. Produce vendors may request a maximum of two (2) stalls and exceptions must be approved by market management. All other vendors are limited to one stall, unless approved with Farmers Market Management. Each regular stall will accommodate a 10'x10' tent. The spaces are numbered on the pavement. The marks are there to provide an adequate amount of space in the event an emergency vehicle needs to get through. Every effort will be made to create an appropriate marketing environment.
- **Tents/Displays/Booths must be appropriately weighted down at all times**. Vendors will be given one warning for their first violation of not having their booth appropriately secured. Subsequent violations will result in a \$25 fine per occurrence.
- Pewaukee / Lake Country Farmers Market welcomes vendors to participate who offer agriculture or craft-based products. No livestock may be sold. No vendor is welcome to participate who has political or lifestyle-based agendas. All clothing, banners, and display materials must also reflect a non-political and /or non-lifestyle-based agenda. All vendor clothing must reflect modesty. Any vendor will be asked to leave if these requirements are not honored.
- Pewaukee / Lake Country Farmers Market requires that all farmers/vendors produce 100% of the products they sell. Vendors shall sell only items that have been approved on the Application submitted. The Farmers Market has sole discretion to add or delete items from the list. The sale of any goods not grown or produced by the vendor is prohibited. Products shall be locally grown, have seasonal integrity and are of high quality. No wholesale loads of produce may be marketed. Persons selling must be family members or paid employees. No brokers, agents, or commissioned sellers may sell produce or products at the markets. **Violation of these rules could result in suspension of your permit for up to one year**. Vendors shall make available for inspection those lands or areas on which produce or products sold at the market are raised or produced.
- Baked goods, canned goods, and on-site prepared foods must follow all Health Department rules. Necessary permits must be included with your application. For further assistance, please contact Environmental Health Sanitarian, at 262-896-8326. Inspections are performed by the Waukesha County Division of Environmental Health.
- **Vendors selling processed food products must provide a copy of their retail food license or food processing plant license at the time of application**. This does not apply to those under Wisconsin's Pickle Bill. If any vendor is deemed to be in violation of health codes pertaining to such products the vendor will be immediately removed from the market for the day and the proper regulatory agency notified.
- Locally made arts and/or crafts may also be sold at the Farmers Market. All products must be handmade. Craft items will be reviewed and will be rejected if found to not be handmade. All craft vendors must provide photos of you creating/assembling your items. No flea market-type items are allowed. Priority will be given to food and garden related vendors seeking Full Season and Peak Season stalls.
- The Market Manager will be on-site by 1:30 pm each Wednesday. **All vendors must be parked by 2:15 pm and will remain until 7:00 pm**. Vendors may not have access to their regular stalls after 2:15 pm. Stalls will be filled with Daily Vendors at 2:15 pm as necessary.

- Vendors not coming to the market must notify the Market Management at 262-737-6170 by 12:00 pm the Tuesday before the market date. After 12:00 pm on Tuesday and on Wednesday by 8:00 am, call the Market Management if you are not coming. If you are not at the Farmers Market and we have not been contacted by you by 2:15 pm your stall may be given to a daily vendor.
- For the safety of other vendors/pedestrians, if you arrive after 2:15 pm you may not be allowed to drive into your space, and your product will have to be hand carried. See market management about safe entry.
- **GENERATORS:** Vendors who intend to use a generator must indicate that on the application form. Generator use at the Market will be limited. **You must have prior permission from the Pewaukee / Lake Country Farmers Market Team to run your generator.** Generators will be inspected by Market Management or staff for noise level, fumes, disturbance to neighboring vendors, and safety. Inspections may be made throughout the season. If your generator does not meet approval, you will need to plan for an alternative power source the following week. If your generator is deemed an immediate safety problem, you will be asked to stop the generator immediately. On a space-available basis in following weeks, your stall assignment may be reassigned to a more appropriate location.
- Vendors and their employees shall conduct themselves in a pleasant and courteous manner to other vendors, customers, and Farmers Market management. Foul language, profanity, or other rude behavior is not permitted. Vendors must cooperate with Farmers Market Management following all rules of operation.
- **Smoking** by vendors is **not permitted** on the grounds of the Farmers Market.
- Vendors may not bring pets and/or animals, alcoholic beverages, or firearms to the Farmers Market.
- Please do not leave children unattended.
- Radios may not be used during market hours. Broadcasting of any type of sound or music must first be approved by Christ Lutheran Church Farmers Market Management. Live musical groups must apply and be placed on the Farmers Market Calendar. All playlists must be family friendly.
- Vendors are required to abide by all Federal, State, County or City laws and regulations regarding the sale of their goods. Copies of all required licenses and/or permits must be with you while attending the Farmers Market.
- Vendors are responsible for collecting and paying any sales tax that may be assessed on their products. Vendors are responsible for filing any and all returns required by state or local governmental authorities.
- When items are being sold by weight, an accurate scale must be used. Scales are subject to inspection by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture.
- Cleanup is immediately following event. All vendors must be cleaned and packed up by 7:45 pm.
- **Garbage & Recycling: We require each vendor to supply a 5 gallon or larger container to be placed at the front of their booth if your booth generates waste.** The information booth will supply garbage signs. All vendors are expected to clean up & sweep their stall area after each market and **take their garbage and recyclables with them.** Failure to do so will result in a service fee of \$25.00 per occurrence. *****The Christ Lutheran Church garbage cans are NOT an option for vendors***.** Vendors found placing waste in the Christ Lutheran Church trashcans will be subject to a \$50 fine from the Farmers Market. If a vendor is found placing waste in the Christ Lutheran Church trashcans a second time, they will be expelled from the Farmers Market for the remainder of the 2023 season.
- If serving food, which may leave grease drippings on ground, please place cardboard on the ground to collect drippings and provide the required trash containers to accommodate waste.
- **We will offer gift certificates for the Farmers Market and you agree to accept them by being a Farmers Market vendor.**
- Vendors must cooperate with the Farmers Market Management and obey all guidelines. If a problem is reported or observed, a vendor will be notified verbally, and then in writing, stating the problem. Failure to respond to the problem will result in termination of the vendor without any refund of any fees.
